

## **Amendments to the Constitution of Whistleblowers Australia Inc.**

### **Rule 5 has been amended (in italics) to read as follows.**

#### 5. Nomination for Membership

(1) A nomination of a person for membership of the association

(a) shall be made by a member of the association in writing ~~in the form set out in Appendix 1 to these rules~~ *by means of a nomination for membership form approved by the committee*; and

(b) shall be lodged with the secretary of the association.

### **Rule 9 has been amended (in italics) to read as follows:**

#### 9. Register of *Committee* Members

(1) The public officer of the association shall establish and maintain a register of *committee* members of the association specifying the name and address of each person who is a *committee* member of the association together with the date on which the person became a *committee* member.

(2) The register of *committee* members shall be *available from the public officer on request and kept at the principal place of administration of the association and shall be open for inspection, free of charge, by any member of the association at any reasonable hour.*
